



Emergency Medical Technician – Basic and Paramedic

UACCB offers a Certificate of Proficiency for EMT Basic and 3 options for EMT Paramedic educational preparation including a Technical Certificate or Associate of Applied Science for EMT Paramedic. Graduates are eligible to take respective National Registry Certification examinations. Certification as an EMT-B is required for entry to the EMT Paramedic program.

Students must earn a grade of C or higher in all general education and EMT major courses to earn certificate or degree.
