Welcome to the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville. UACCB is a comprehensive community college committed to providing learning experiences that improve the lives of those we serve.

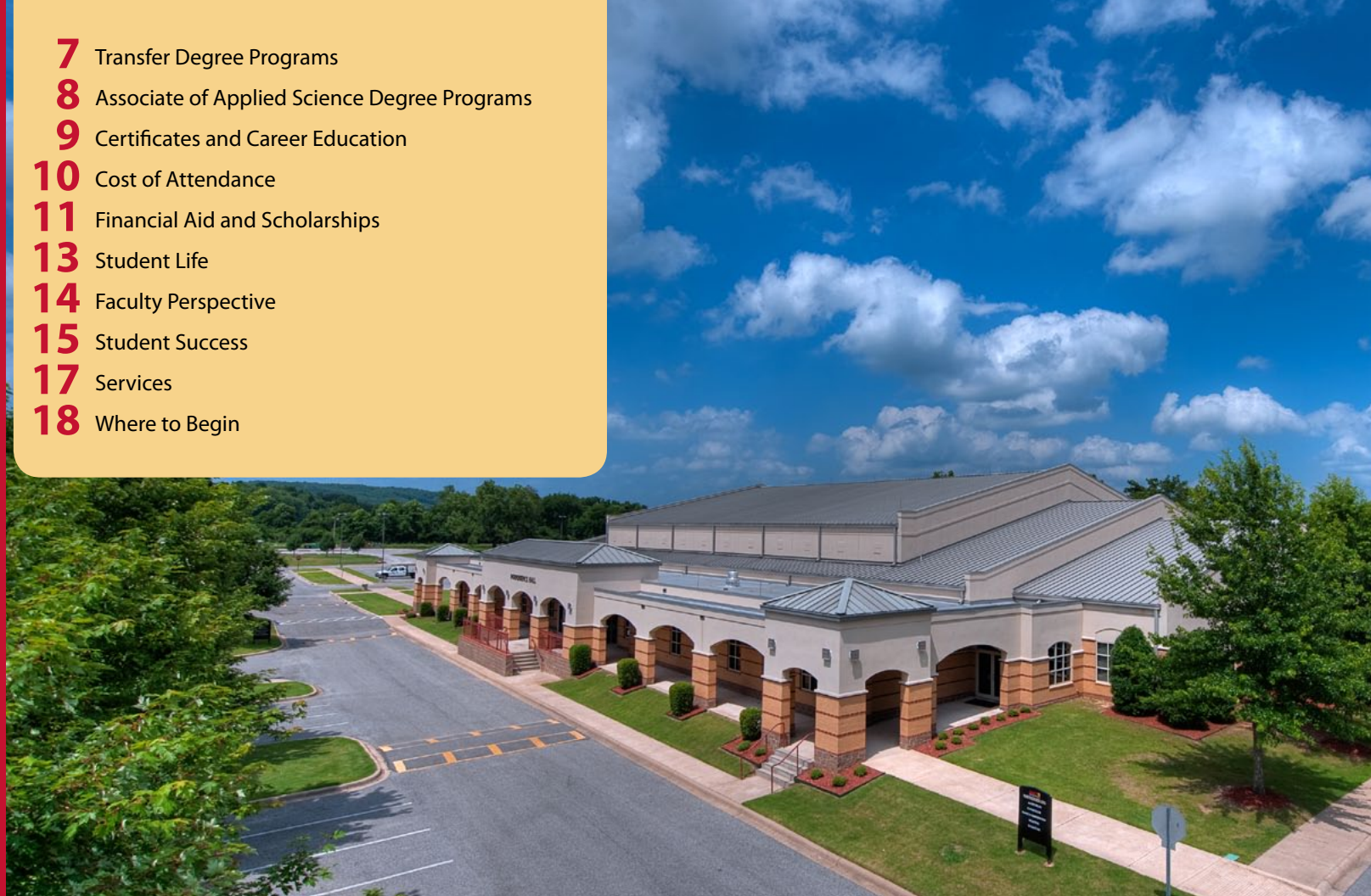

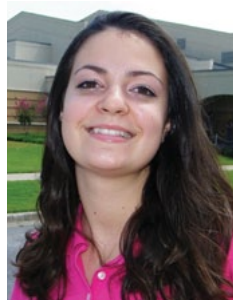
UACCB's nursing licensure pass rates continue to exceed the national average.

How To Apply

The University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville is an open admissions institution. Our Enrollment Specialists can help you complete the application process and enroll at UACCB—the first step in earning your degree!

First time college students will need to submit the following information to the Enrollment Center:

1. A completed Application for Admission
Get an application at www.uaccb.edu or by calling the Enrollment Center at (870) 612-2000.
2. An official transcript of high school grades, credits, and date of graduation; a General Equivalency Diploma (GED) transcript; or a proven ability-to-benefit from college courses.*
3. Proof of immunization against measles and rubella.
(Two measles shots, one rubella and one mumps are required with the first immunization dated one year after date of birth.)
4. ACT, ASSET, COMPASS or SAT scores that are less than 5 years old

* Home school students must submit an accredited home school transcript, GED transcript, or meet the minimum requirements for ability-to-benefit admission, along with other documents listed above.

** Transfer students are required to submit transcripts from all previously attended institutions
