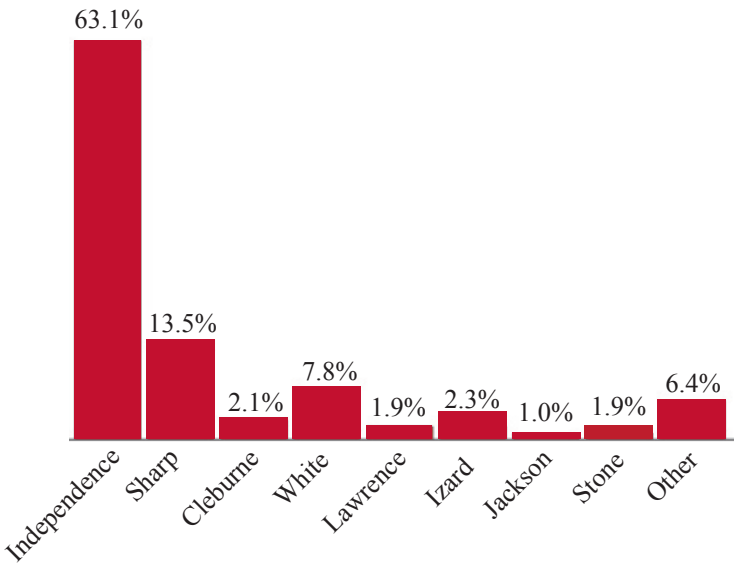

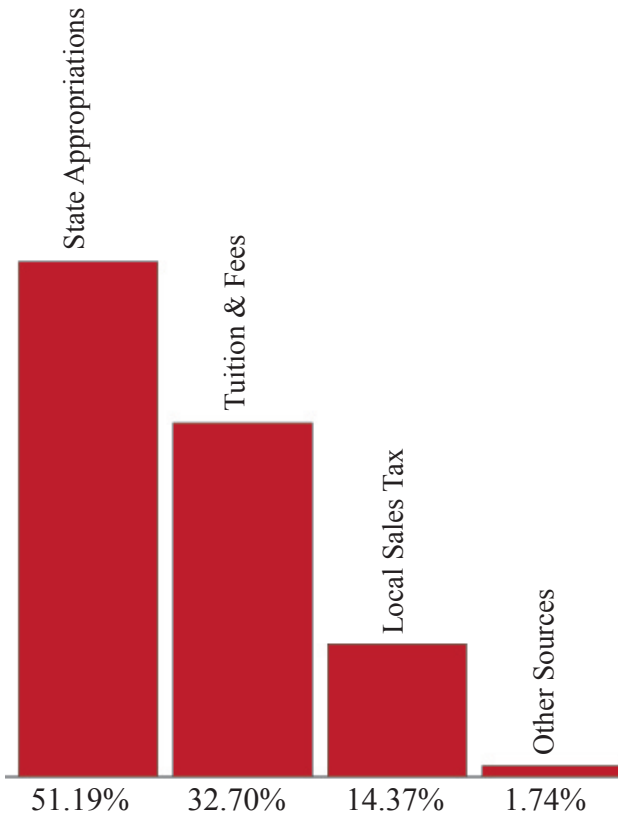

## UACCB Financial Aid Students receiving aid 2016-2017

### Institutional Scholarships for the 2016-17 academic year

523 (37%) received a UACCB institutional  
scholarship totaling \$334,946.



UACCB has 11 buildings on 58 acres. The total square footage of buildings is 162,044 square feet on-site. The newest building on campus is the Cosmetology Building, which houses a full-service salon that provides services to the public. UACCB also has an Adult Education Center in Highland that provides services to Sharp County residents.
