Definition of Power Series

f x is a variable, then an infinite series of the form

 $\sum_{n=0}^{\infty} a_n x^n = a_0 + a_1 x + a_2 x^2 + \dots + a_n$

is called a power series, center at zero.

More constantly, an infinite series of the form $\sum_{n=0}^{\infty} (x-c)^n = a_0 + a_1(x-c) + a_2(x-c)^2 + \cdots$




