



UACCB Financial Aid Students receiving aid 2018-2019

722 (44%) received Pell Grants (\$2,947,051) 1054 (64%) received some form of need-based aid (\$4,081,952).

Institutional Scholarships for the 2018-19 academic year 532 (32%) received a UACCB institutional scholarship totaling \$422,205.



UACCB has 12 buildings on 58 acres. The total square footage of buildings is 177,044 square feet on-site. The newest building on campus is the Workforce Training Center, which houses industrial technology programs as well as a makerspace. UACCB also has an Adult Education Center in Highland that provides services to Sharp County residents.
