Compensation Procedure for Full-Time Faculty Teaching Summer Terms While Off-Appointment

I. Overview

The purpose of this procedure is to identify the formula for compensating full-time faculty teaching during summer terms while off-appointment. It is recognized that full-time faculty who teach in the summer will, by default, perform more college-related work than simply teaching a class. Inevitably other institutional service work will be performed. A procedure has been established in order to compensate full-time faculty for off-contract summer assignments.

II. Practice

Full-time faculty who are off-appointment and who teach a summer term course will be paid \$2,000.00 for a three credit hour class or \$666.67 per credit hour.
