Foundation Scholarships

I. Overview

This procedure provides a mechanism by which the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville Foundation provides scholarships.

II. Practice

UACCB Foundation scholarships are administered according to donors' intent and awarded only to students who have applied for admission to UACCB. Foundation scholarships are awarded based upon the availability of funds and are outlined in the UACCB catalog and on the UACCB website. Application deadlines are April 1, July 1 and December 1.

Applications are submitted to the Director of Development and reviewed by a campus committee appointed by the Director unless otherwise noted in the UACCB catalog or on the UACCB website. The Director of Development is responsible for notifying students of award status. Awards will be applied to the recipients account and any overpayment of tuition will be refunded to the recipient by the business office at a later date (unless otherwise requested by the donor and outlined in the scholarship agreement.)

Students receiving foundation scholarships are expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress, GPA of 2.0 or higher (unless otherwise noted) for the semester the scholarship is awarded and complete 75 percent of their coursework. Once a foundation scholarship is revoked, a student will not be eligible to receive future foundation scholarships until he/she has a GPA of 2.0 or higher and/or the student has completed at least one semester where he/she completed at least 75 percent of their coursework.

III. Clarifying Points

Foundation scholarships are awarded for the fall and spring unless otherwise noted in the UACCB catalog or the UACCB website. Exceptions to this practice must be approved by the Director of Development or the Chancellor.
