**I. Purpose and Scope**

This procedure provides a mechanism by which the University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville provides scholarships.

**III. Procedure**

UACCB scholarships are administered according to college guidelines and awarded only to students who have applied for admission to UACCB. All scholarships are awarded based upon the availability of funds. The application priority deadline is July 1. To qualify students must be first time entering college students. Scholarships and requirements are outlined below:

Scholarship	Requirements	Award Amount	Renewal
Chancellor's Scholarship	Composite ACT of 27  OR  Accuplacer average of 275	\$3,000 for the academic year  (\$1,500 in fall, \$1,500 in spring)	12 credit hours completed each semester AND 3.00 GPA minimum cumulative GPA. <i>Renewable for 3 consecutive semesters</i>
Academic Excellence Scholarship	Composite ACT of 23  OR  Accuplacer average of 266	\$2,500 for the academic year  (\$1,250 in fall, \$1,250 in spring)	12 credit hours completed each semester AND 3.00 GPA minimum cumulative GPA. <i>Renewable for 3 consecutive semesters</i>
Academic Distinction Scholarship	Composite ACT of 19  OR  Accuplacer average of 246	\$2,000 for the academic year  (\$1,000 in fall, \$1,000 in spring)	12 credit hours completed each semester AND 3.00 GPA minimum cumulative GPA. <i>Renewable for 3 consecutive semesters</i>
<sup>1</sup> Achievement Scholarship	Arkansas Scholar OR First place Skills USA OR HOSA state officer OR Valedictorian or Salutatorian	\$1,000 for the academic year  (\$500 in fall, \$500 in spring)	12 credit hours completed each semester AND 3.00 GPA minimum cumulative GPA. <i>Renewable for 3 consecutive semesters</i>

<sup>1</sup>Achievement scholarship recipients must be first time entering students in the first semester following high school graduation.

Limit one institutional scholarship per student. Students are defaulted to the highest-level scholarship they qualify.

Summer courses are not eligible for institutional scholarships.

Exceptions to the practice must be approved by Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs
