

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL RESOURCES

UACCB offers scholarships to qualifying students and are renewable for three consecutive semesters if a minimum of 12 credit hours are completed each semester, and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is maintained. Limit one Institutional Scholarship per student.
