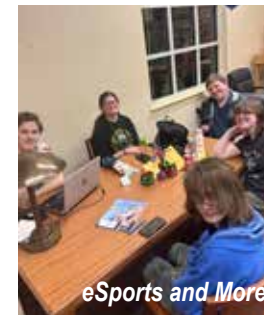

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL RESOURCES

UACCB offers scholarships to qualifying students entering college for the first time and are renewable for three consecutive semesters if a minimum of 12 credit hours are completed each semester, and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is maintained. Limit one Institutional Scholarship per student.

JUMP-START YOUR FUTURE!

Students can get a jump-start on their future by taking college courses for free or reduced cost as early as their freshman year of high school. Courses are offered online and on-campus with bus transportation provided by most school districts.

If you are currently in high school and would like to take classes for college credit, follow the steps below:

- Complete an application for admission at www.uaccb.edu/apply.
- Submit the following documents to the Admissions Office to complete your admissions file:
 - Current high school transcript. Must be in a sealed envelope or mailed directly from the high school.
 - Placement scores (Accuplacer, or ACT). UACCB offers the Accuplacer exam on our campus. Please visit our Testing Center for more information.
 - Proof of immunization (shot records). Arkansas state law requires that you submit two MMR immunizations (measles, mumps, rubella). These immunizations can be obtained at your local health center.
 - Letter of recommendation from counselor or principal.

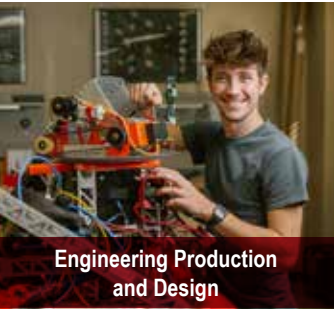

There are several transfer scholarships available, including the University of Arkansas Transfer Achievement Scholarship which allows UACCB students to transfer to UA Fayetteville without your existing tuition rate increasing. This scholarship is applicable to UACCB's online and on-campus degrees.
