Campus Security

I. Purpose and Scope

This policy is established to ensure that campus conduct policies are followed and for the safe and efficient use of parking and roadways on college property. It outlines the fines and procedures for individuals who violate these regulations while on campus.

This policy applies to all students, faculty, staff, and visitors visiting the college or operating a motor vehicle on college-owned or controlled property.

II. Parking and Traffic Regulations

All vehicles operated on campus must adhere to posted signs, road markings, and official college guidelines, including:

- Parking only in designated areas
- Displaying a valid parking permit (if a student or employee)
- Obeying speed limits and traffic signs
- Yielding to pedestrians
- Refraining from blocking fire lanes, driveways, loading zones, or accessible/disabled parking spaces

III. Violation Categories

Campus Safety Officers may opt to provide a verbal or written warning for the first offense in lieu of a fine.

Violation Category
No valid parking permit displayed
Parking in unauthorized or reserved area
Blocking a fire lane or emergency access
Parking in accessible/disabled space without proper permit
Double parking or obstructing other vehicles
Exceeding campus speed limit
Reckless or unsafe driving
Failure to yield to pedestrians
Tampering with parking enforcement devices

IV. Appeals

- Individuals may appeal a citation within 10 business days of the ticket issue date in writing to the Director of Campus Safety at safety@uaccb.edu.
- Appeals will be reviewed by the Campus Safety Committee. Decisions made by the Campus Safety Committee are final.

V. Repeated Offenses

Repeated violations (3 or more citations in an academic year; or 2 or more of the same citation in an academic year) may result in:

- Temporary or permanent loss of campus parking privileges.
- Temporary or permanent loss of access to campus.
- Referral to Student Conduct Review or Human Resources, as applicable.

VI. Vehicle Immobilization and Towing

Vehicles may be booted or towed at the owner's expense for:

- Parking in a fire lane or blocking emergency access
- Repeated violations despite prior warnings of being a habitual offender
