The University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville (UACCB) is proud to offer Kids' College 2019. Kids' College is a summer academic



enrichment program designed to spark the imagination and expand the knowledge of youth who will enter grades 1-6 in the fall of 2019. Kids' College is **July 8-12** for students entering grades 1-3; **July 15-19** for students entering grades 4-6. This year's theme is "Made In America." Potential instructors are encouraged to design classes that celebrate our homeland's national landmarks, freedom, democracy, commerce or culture. Classes offered should include hands-on activities and projects that incorporate science, technology, engineering, math, art, theater or language. Please include 3-4 learning outcomes with each of your course proposals. **You can submit up to 4 (four) class proposals.** First year instructors are paid \$25/hour. With prior approval, UACCB will furnish copies, supplies and materials for classes. Most classrooms are equipped with smartboards upon request. Classes are limited to approximately 14-16 students. Volunteers are generally available to assist teachers with specific needs.

Course Proposal

For a full-day Kids' College student, we offer 4 (four) 75-minute daily class sessions for the week. Please submit a course proposal for <u>each class</u> you propose to teach. **Duplicate this page, so that you can submit up to 4 (four) class proposals per week.** For example, *Wacky Science* class could be offered once to be taught every day for 5 days - or the same class could be offered up to 4 different times if that is the only class you propose to teach. Each course proposal should reflect an age-appropriate 5-day lesson plan that includes learning outcomes. Feel free to use additional paper for your lesson plan(s) if needed. *The number of classes taught is based on the classes that make*. If all four classes make, then you will teach four classes per week. If one class makes, then you will teach one class per week.
